## Morning Club:

- Morning Club is open to pupils from Reception to Year 6.
- Entry is from 8.00am until 8.10am.
- Sessions are now available to book for the Summer Term. Sessions can be booked for the whole term or on a daily/weekly basis.
- Morning Club cost will remain at 50p per day for the childcare element.
- Bookings and payments will need to be made through School Gateway.
